Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Alabama Foundation for Oncology encourages and expects its employees/ volunteers, who are involved in Camp Newhope / Camp Newsong to exercise the judgment and care in relation to the well-being of campers that any reasonable and prudent person would be expected to demonstrate under such circumstances.

However, the Alabama Foundation for Oncology recognizes and reminds parents of the fact that in any activity involving children moving from one place to another, or being in a public setting, there are inherent risks.

Therefore, when the parent or guardian signs permission for their son/daughter to participate in camp activities, they acknowledge their understanding of such risks.

And, in as much as the parent or guardian understands the risks, their signature also is an agreement that they will hereby release, remise, and forever discharge, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the Alabama Foundation for Oncology, its board, employees, volunteers, and other representatives, and/or any one more of any thereof against any claim, demand, or cause of action whether now in existence or hereafter arising, for any injury to the person of or the death of the participant, arising out of, resulting from, caused by, occurring during, or in any way connected with the camp.
